

Toyota and Scion Maintenance Service Benefits For vehicles with a 16,000 km oil change schedule

ECP Benefits:

To maintain the quality of the investment you made in your new Toyota/Scion, regular maintenance is required every 6 months or 8,000 km, whichever comes first.

SPECIAL OPERATING CONDITIONS

If you primarily operate your vehicle under any of the following conditions, please refer to *additional maintenance requirements*, shown below:

- Driving on dirt roads or dusty roads
- Extensive idling and/or low-speed driving for long distances, such as police, taxi or door-to-door delivery service
- Towing a trailer, using a camper or car top carrier

ADDITIONAL MAINTENANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Inspect brakes, steering and suspension components every 6 months/8,000km
- Inspect driveshaft boots and body/chassis bolts, every 6 months/8 000km
- Change manual transmission oil every 36 months/48,000 km
- Replace automatic transmission fluid every 72 months/96,000 km

Maintenance Services:

SERVICE #1

- Inspect & adjust all fluid levels
- Reset maintenance reminder light (if applicable)
- Remove & inspect cabin air filter (replace if needed 1)
- Remove & inspect engine air filter (replace if needed 1)
- Inspect wiper blades, linkage & washers for proper operation
- Check installation of driver's floor mat
- Check & adjust tire pressures (including spare)
- Remove wheels & visually inspect brake pads, calipers, rotors, brake lines & hoses ¶
- Check & record tire tread depth
- Examine tires for damage & uneven wear
- Rotate tires (applicable to same size wheels, front & rear) or alternatively perform season tire change-over (tires mounted on rims); extra charges will apply if seasonal tires are not mounted on rims
- Record inspection results, measurements θ component conditions on inspection form θ/or repair order
- Road-test vehicle

SERVICE #2

- Replace engine oil δ oil filter (0W20 or 0W30 as required)
- Lubricate locks, latches & hinges
- Inspect lights, horn & wipers for proper function
- Check coolant, brake, transmission & washer fluid levels (fill as required)
- Visually inspect drive belts (adjust tension if required)
- Tighten & lubricate propeller/drive shaft (if applicable)
- Inspect differential & transfer case vents for obstruction (if applicable)

SERVICE #3

- 12 Volt battery service & comprehensive electrical charging system evaluation
- Inspect valve clearance audibly
- Adjust belt tension (if required)
- Check steering gear linkage & shock absorbers for looseness, damage or leakage
- Inspect ball joints & dust covers, driveshafts, chassis nuts & bolts for looseness or damage
- Inspect fuel system for leaks or damage, inspect condition of fuel tank band, fuel tank cap gasket, fuel tank vapour vent system hoses, fuel lines θ connections
- Inspect exhaust system for leaks, damage or broken hangers

 \P The maintenance benefits do not include any items that require periodic replacement, such as engine air filters, cabin air filters, wiper blades, belts, hoses, or brake pads.

The 36 MTH/48K maintenance service includes brake fluid replacement which is required as indicated in the Toyota/Scion Owner's Manual Supplement.
